NIT Silchar, NIAIMT ink MoU on skill development

SILCHAR, July 6: The National Institute for Automotive Inspection, Maintenance and Training (NIAIMT)-Silchar and the National Institute of Technology (NIT)-Silchar formalized a strategic partnership through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) aimed at strengthening skill development programmes and advancing research in automotive and transportation engineering.

The MoU was signed between Dr Ashim Kumar Roy, Registrar of NIT Silchar and Dr Aninda Bijoy Paul, Senior Advisor and Site Head, NIAIMT-Silchar in the presence of Prof Dilip Kumar Baidya, director NIT Silchar and other faculty members and officials of both institutes.

As per the MoU, the two institutes will share infrastructure, enabling NIT Silchar students to access NIAIMT's automated inspection lanes and driving tracks,

and co-develop curricula and certification courses. Joint research projects will target transportation safety, driver behaviour, modelling and low-emission powertrains, while coordinated workshops and internships will bridge academia and industry, producing a new generation of skilled automotive engineers and technicians.

* Dr Aninda Bijoy Paul, while talking to *The Assam Tribune* said, "This landmark collaboration is the first between two premier institutes of national importance from southern Assam, and is expected to catalyse regional socio-economic development by fostering innovation, enhancing employability, and contributing to a safer, more efficient transport ecosystem in Northeast India."

On the other hand, Prof Mokaddes Ali Ahmed, head, Department of Civil Engineering at NIT Silchar expressed happiness over the developments and said that

while the NIAIMT has the updated and sophisticated machinery, the collaboration, aimed to strengthen skill development trainings in this region and bolster research and development on automotive domain and transportation engineering, will get a massive facelift.
